TRANSPERSONAL CONTEMPLATIVE ART-BASED COUNSELING Program Prerequisites

Prerequisites must be completed prior to beginning coursework, but need not be completed prior to applying. Applicants cannot take prerequisites alongside their graduate coursework at Naropa University. Thus, students can work on their prerequisites as they are in the process of applying to the program.

A grade of "C" or above is required for all prerequisite coursework. All prerequisites are to be completed at accredited academic institutions for credit and a grade (not pass/fail or audited).

Psychology Prerequisites (12 semester credit hours)

- One 3 semester credit course in Abnormal Psychology
- One 3 semester credit course in Developmental Psychology
- Two 3 semester credit courses in psychology electives (example courses: Introduction to Psychology/General Psychology, Theories of Personality)

Studio Art Prerequisites (18 semester credit hours)

- One 3 semester credit art studio course in Drawing
- One 3 semester credit art studio course in Painting
- One 3 semester credit art studio course in a 3D medium (Sculpture or Ceramics)
- Three 3 semester credit courses in studio art electives (9 credits total)
